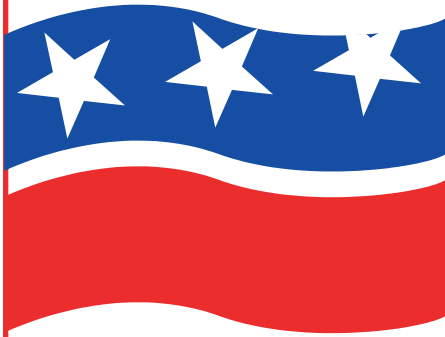

## The 5th Annual *We the People* Chicago Metro Summer Institute — July 12-14, 2010

The Summer Institute is a three-day professional development program to prepare participants to teach in-depth lessons on the U.S. Constitution. Up to 24 Illinois teachers from all grade levels can apply.

### Lecture, Teaching Method and Assessment of Content address the following issues:

- ★ How have the protections of the Bill of Rights been developed and expanded?
- ★ What Rights do the Bill of Rights protect?

### The three days will include:

- ★ Classes: A leading Constitutional Scholar (Dr. Richard Hardy) will lecture and lead discussions on aspects of the U.S. Constitution.
- ★ Lesson Demonstrations: Elementary, middle and high school teachers demonstrate *We the People...* curriculum, and serve as mentors to assist and advise participants.
- ★ The Simulated Congressional Hearing will be the culminating activity of the institute.
- ★ Academic credit from North Park University will be available and CPDU's.
- ★ A \$100 stipend will be given to all participants
- ★ Refreshments and lunch will be included each day.
